23 Activities contributing to the Cancer Mission objectives by Ministry of Science and Innovation (1)

- The strategy in the last three years is focused on funding (by grants, loans, credits, etc.) cancer financing schemes that strengthen public health institutions, research groups and also industry by financing projects, hospital infrastructures and industry.
- Spanish Government implemented a strategic project for economic recovery and transformation (PERTE) from EU funds that refers to innovative procedures to improve the prevention, diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of patients in a personalized way.
- Research structures have been created such as IMPaCT programme, a precision medicine infrastructure associated with science and technology configured by three programmes, predictive medicine, data science and genomic medicine.





Activities contributing to the Cancer Mission objectives by Ministry of Science and Innovation (2)

- The Instituto de Salud Carlos III (ISCIII) that implemented the IMPaCT programme also financed a personalized medicine programme (EU funds) to implement in clinical practice that drives those research results to the service of citizen's care in public hospitals.
- In addition in collaboration with the Centre for the Development of Technology and Innovation (CDTI), research projects have been implemented, coordinating groups from research institutions and industry to transfer research results to clinical practice.
- Along with this strategy ISCIII has issued a call for the Creation of an R&D+i structure for advanced network therapies named CERTERA, that allows the existing designs to be structured throughout the whole country.
