

Summary Report of the National Workshop on Advice on Intersectoral Tools for Health: Health impact assessment

Summary report

The General Directorate of Public Health, Quality and Innovation of the Spanish Ministry of Health, Social Services and Equality (MSSSI) organized, as a partner of the Equity Action project, the National Workshop: Advice on Intersectoral Tools for Health: Health impact assessment.

This workshop was framed in the <u>Work Package 4</u> of the Equity Action "Tools to improve the health equity focus in cross government policy making".

The workshop took place the **13th and 14th of February 2014** in Madrid, at the MSSSI (Programme in Annex 1). There were 35 participants, all of them from the public health sector. They came from the regional level (27 professionals) and the national level (7 professionals).

The technical guidance of the workshop was ensured by Dr. Orielle Solar who is now working as a Research Director of the Employment, Health, Work and Equity Programme at FLACSO Chile.

Workshop Objectives:

- To understand the role and importance of intersectoral action/health in all policies approach on the design of interventions on social determinants of health, and its integration on the health plans.
- To analyze different intersectoral models and their contribution to the reduction of health inequities.
- To analyze tools and indicators for intersectoral work, such as health impact assessment.

Methodology

The methodology was based on theoretical sessions on the core contents, with debate spaces about the presentations, participants discussion and work in groups around some specific activities.

The two tools on intersectoral action which were used at the workshop are available in Spanish at annex 2 and 3.

The workshop development aimed to deepen on the knowledge through the discussion about selected experiences, and to organize a collective synthesis on the key contents developed at the workshop.

We had also the opportunity of presenting, sharing and discussing the case studies on Health Impact Assessment carried out by the two Spanish partners of the Equity Action that participated in WP4: the Basque Government and the General Directorate of





Public Health, Quality and Innovation of the Spanish Ministry of Health, Social Services and Equality.

Workshop evalulation:

A workshop evaluation form was completed by the participants (30 of 36 completed it). The workshop was valued **positively with 7.8 points** on a scale of 1 to 10.

The design and objectives of the workshop, the teaching methodology, the documentation provided and the usefulness of the acquired knowledge has been classified as excellent or good by 75% or more of the participants (from the 4 eligible categories: excellent/good/fair/deficient).

Regarding the length of the workshop, 59% of the participants considered it as appropiate.

The trainer received also positive comments with a 9.5 score for her level of knowledge, 7.9 for her training methodology and 9.1 for the attention she gave to the participants, on a scale of 1 to 10.

When asked to the participants <u>what they liked the most</u> about the workshop the most common answer was: the specific tools to assess Intersectorality that were presented. Also participants highlighted the interest of the topic and the work carried out in the "work in group" sessions. Regarding the <u>areas for improvement</u> one mentioned by various participants was the length of the workshop (requesting for more time). It was also proposed to do it more practical with less theory, by sharing more experiences.

Regarding the <u>suggestions</u> that were done by the participants, a remarkable one was the proposal of organizing similar seminars at the local level to work with other health sectors. They argued it would be interesting to replicate it in the regions.

Conclusions:

This national workshop on "Advice on Intersectoral Tools for Health: Health impact assessment" will contribute to the development of actions to move forward health and equity in all policies.

Specifically, we are confident it will have an impact on the implementation of the Spanish National Strategy on Health Promotion and Disease Prevention which is now a national political priority. This Strategy was approved the last 18th of December by the National Health System Interterritorial Council². We are currently working on the

implementation process in which we have the goal of including the health equity and social determinants of health approach, since equity was established as one of the key principles of the strategy.

For an effective and equitable implementation of this strategy, we are absolutely convinced of the need of integrating intersectoral action at all the implementation levels (national, regional and local).

In this sense, having practical tools and sharing good practices and experiences such as the ones presented by Orielle Solar and shared by other participants are really useful for us.
