




Figura 11. Tendencia de la mortalidad por cáncer en España (1975-2018) (población estándar europea)

- **European Code Against Cancer**
- **HPV and BHV vaccination: successful strategy**

- **Cancer screening programs:**
 - 2021: 1.500.000€ to colorectal cancer screening and 2.500.000€ to cervical cancer screening
 - 2022: 3.000.000€ to each screening program
 - 2023: 3.000.000€ to each screening program



- **Psychological care** for cancer patients
- **Individualized care plans** to follow-up **cancer survivors**
- **Right to be forgotten** for cancer survivors


- Model of cancer care organization based on **multidisciplinary care**
- Development of a model of **Reference Centres/Units (CSUR) for rare tumours** within the NHS (adults and childhood)
- **Paediatric Oncology Agreement**
- **Personalized approaches** to cancer treatment
