## **Background and Method**

HIV-related stigma is a critical determinant in the quality of life of people living with HIV.

Aim: to describe the manifestations of stigma experienced by PLHIV in Spain.

Cross-sectional study in eight Spanish regions with the collaboration of 28 centers (14 NGOs and 14 hospitals).

Adapted version of the HIV Stigma Index version 2.0 administered to 500 PLHIV.







# Disclosure of their HIV status








They lived their status fully openly (i. e., public visibility)

# **Anticipated stigma**








#### **Self-exclusion**


#### 2 out of 10 decided <u>not to engage</u> <u>in sexual or romantic relationships</u> within the last year



## **Enacted stigma**





To prevent and eradicate all forms of discrimination and effectively protect victims in all areas: education, health, culture and labor.






