

LIST OF RISK AND HIGH RISK COUNTRIES

(General Directorate of Public Health Regulation of June 4th, 2021 regarding the health controls to be carried out at the points of entry in Spain)

VALIDITY: This list will come into force at 00:00 hours on 4th March, 2022 and will be valid until 23:59 hours on 6th April, 2022.

RISK COUNTRIES

Countries in which a certificate or document certifying vaccination, an active infection diagnostic test (AIDT) or recovery from COVID-19 is required.

Countries and areas in the European Union/European Economic Area

Note: the areas included in brackets ARE NOT CONSIDERED TO BE AT RISK. If no areas are specified, the whole country is considered at risk.

HIGH RISK COUNTRIES

Countries where dual certification is required: a certificate or document certifying vaccination or recovery from COVID-19 AND a COVID-19 active infection diagnostic test (AIDT).
