NATIONAL AIDS REGISTRY. SITUATION AS OF 30 JUNE 2010

The National AIDS Case Registry provides information about the evolution of this disease in Spain. When interpreting the data presented in this report, it should be kept in mind that the incidence of AIDS is an indicator of the frequency and evolution of advanced states of HIV infection in the population. This is a key indicator for the evaluation of treatment effectiveness, but it does not provide information on the frequency of new HIV infections in the population or on their recent evolution; it may be that new infections are increasing while cases of AIDS follow another trend. Interpretation of these data should also take into account that the numbers corresponding to recent years may be slightly modified in the future as reporting is completed.

According to reports received in the National AIDS Case Registry up to 30 June 2010, it is estimated that, after correcting for reporting delay, 1,200 cases of AIDS were diagnosed in Spain in 2009. After reaching a peak in the mid 1990s, the number of reported AIDS cases has progressively declined; the cases reported in 2009 represent a reduction of 82.2% with respect to those reported in 1996, the year before highly active antiretroviral treatments came into general use (Figure 1).

As compared to 2008, the number of cases in 2009 declined by 15% in men and by 16.1% in women (Table 7B and Figures 1 and 3). The downward trend that began some years before in injecting drug users (IDU) or ex-users has continued, as seen in the 22% reduction in the number of cases diagnosed. In the same period, the number of cases attributed to unprotected sexual relations between men also declined (by 5%), as well as those attributed to heterosexual transmission (by 15%) (Figure 2).








Figure 5. AIDS cases diagnosed in Spain in 2009

To date, 1,037 diagnosed cases have been reported in 2009. It is estimated that this figure represents 86% of the total number of cases that will be registered by the time reporting is completed. Some 77% of AIDS diagnoses occurred in men, and the mean age at diagnosis was around 41 years. The proportion of paediatric cases (under age 13) was around 0.3%. About 32% of persons who developed AIDS in 2009 contracted the infection by sharing injection material for intravenous drug administration. Those who contracted the infection due to unprotected heterosexual relations make up about 32% of cases. Although in absolute numbers this type of transmission affects men more than women, it is especially important in the latter group as it represents 60% of reported AIDS cases diagnosed in women in 2009. The third most frequent transmission route was homosexual relations between men, which represents 23% of all cases, and 30% of those affecting men (Figure 5). Accordingly, there is an overall predominance of sexual transmission, representing 57% of new cases of AIDS in 2009.

Since the beginning of the epidemic in Spain, a total of 79,363 cases of AIDS have been reported.

Until 1997 the proportion of AIDS cases in persons from countries other than Spain was less than 3%. But beginning in 1998 this figure rose progressively, reaching 31% in 2009. In that year, 45% of these foreign-born persons were from Latin America, and 31% from countries in Africa.

In the period 2004-2008, tuberculosis at any site remained the most frequent AIDS-defining disease, affecting 29% of cases. It was followed by pneumonia due to *Pneumocystis jirovecii* (23%) and by esophageal candidiasis (14%) (Figure 6).

Despite the marked decline in AIDS incidence since the spread of new antiretroviral treatments, Spain continues to be one of the countries with the highest incidence of AIDS in Western Europe. Maintaining the downward trend will require strengthened interventions to promote HIV testing, counselling and early diagnosis of persons with risk practices, in addition to reinforced prevention measures.

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




