

Public

€ 99.3 billion/year

7.4% GDP
€ 2,079 per inhabitant
7 out of 10 euros dedicated to curative care
rehabilitation, and long-term care in prescriptions for medication
€ 14.1 billion



Private

€ 34.7 billion/year

2.6% GDP
€ 726 per inhabitant
9 out of 10 euros are direct payments by households, mainly for curative care and rehabilitation (including dental care), medication (including co-payment), lenses and hearing aids.


