Sex differentials in health

- ◉ Due to genetic sex
- ◉ Or gendered socialization
- ◉ Not purely academic – but on the argument that gendered causes of death and disability are amenable to social change

Definitions

Sex: developmental differentiations due to inherited sex chromosomes
(46,XX vs 46,XY karyotypes)

Gender: constellation of social expectations, responsibilities & obstacles in response to your phenotype

Global Burden of Disease

Disability-adjusted life years (DALYs)

- sum of healthy years lost to early death or disability
- without age-weighting
- Not discounted
- DALY [0,0]

Limited by epidemiology, disability weights

Gendered Vulnerabilities


Male gender vulnerabilities	Female gender vulnerabilities

Disparate clusters


- Depression


Sex differences in global DALYs lost to panic disorder (GBD 2002)




Sex differences in global DALYs lost to post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
